THE SHEPHERD'S CORNER WITH...

Reticulation is probably a word you probably do not often use. It is a word used in several fields of endeavor. In the medical world it can refer to the fibers and blood vessels that interact to support the life of an organ. In the church world, reticulation refers to the interaction between people and groups that brings life and vitality to the congregation.

Look at it this way: if a person from care group A interacts with a person from small group B, and then one of these two interacts with a person from group C, we have reticulation. Why is that important? Eccl. 4 talks about two people being much stronger than one, and verse 12 says "a 3 fold cord is not easily broken."

Likewise, there is strength – in this case spiritual strength – when care and concern moves from one group to another per reticulation.

Sometimes a large church is defined as a bunch of smaller churches sharing the same staff and facilities. But each "small church" must realize it does not stand alone – it is part of the whole congregation. Each smaller group interacts with the other groups to carry life and function to the congregation.

Do you know everybody at CCY? Did not think so! You do not need to know each one in a personal way. Through reticulation you can know the congregation in a serving way and allow CCY to stand strong for Christ and Christian outreach.
