WEEK 16 REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. Are you more sensitive to sin and brokenness in yourself as a Christian than before hand? If so why?
2. 2 Sam 11 – List the many things David did wrong in this passage. Can you see the progression of sin?
3. 2 Sam 12 – How do you think David felt when he finally got the point of Nathan's story?
4. Lev 14:4-7/ Heb 9:19-22 – Why kill one bird and release the other?
5. Psalms 52 – Are you "flourishing in the house of God"? If not what is lacking? If you are what helps you?

WEEK 17 REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. I Sam 22 Do you think David is responsible for the deaths of the priests?
2. Psalms 53 What tempts you to think "there is no God"? What changes your mind? 3. Psalms 5:4-6, what does God do to the wicked/arrogant/deceitful?
3. Psalms 54 Has your Faith ever been attacked? If so how did you handle it?
4. Psalms 55 How do you respond to troubles? How are you handling your biggest problems today?

1. I Peter 5:7/Ps 55:22 What does it look like to "cast your cares on the Lord?"
2. Psalms 56/ I Sam 21:10-15 David's situation is dire. What does David do when he is afraid?
3. Read I Sam 16:1-13 What is God's purpose for David?
4. Psalms 57/ I sam 24 David is hiding in a cave and has the opportunity to kill Saul. What prevents David from doing that? Psalms 57:2

WEEK 19 REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. Psalms 50/ I Sam 19 David cried out to God to be His fortress and protect him. How did God protect him? How does God protect you?
2. Psalms 60/ II Samuel 8:13 What did David attribute to his military success. Psalms 60:11? Do you recognize the source of your success in you life?
3. Psalms 60:4 When armies have disorganized soldiers fleeing they raise a banner to reorganize them. Who does God raise a banner for and what does that look like in your life?
4. Psalms 61:3-5 What fellowship of God does David want? What would that kind of fellowship look like in your life?

WEEK 20 REFLECTION QUESTIONS

1. Psalms 62:11-12 What two things has he heard about God? Do you think of God this way?
2. Psalms 65 What does God provide vs. 9-13? What has God provided for you?
3. Psalms 66: 6 What event is David referring to? Even though David was not at this event, he rejoices to God for it. What events from the Bible give you hope in your present life?
4. Psalms 66: 9-12 What events did God use as a test? Do you have any events in your life that could have been God's test of refining?
5. Psalms 66:16 What can you do to get better at telling others about what God has done for you?
