## IN OUR COMMUNITY

Christ's Closet is a place where people in the community can come to get free clothing as well as a meal and prayer. We have gone from 4 families signing in when we first opened in October 2015 to an average of 25 families each Saturday we are open. Our largest events have had 178 and 70 families sign in.

With these numbers we have a lot of prep work and hours that go into making these days successful. We have a wonderful team of volunteers that make this possible. Most Saturdays we average about 12 volunteers for a total average of 48 volunteer hours. During the week preceding the closet there are several hours of preparation including planning of lunch, crafts and shopping for supplies. Occasionally some volunteers will come during the week to sort. We see God working through this ministry every time the closet is open and even in between. One particular time really touched me. We had a couple in our church donate a car seat the year before last. We set it out and towards the end of the closet we saw a lady looking at it. We spoke with her about taking it and she was reluctant. She thought someone else might need it more. Her daughter was pregnant and in an abusive relationship.

Her daughter lived out of state and she was going to be bringing her back to live here. She didn't have much nor the means to purchase what she needed. We convinced her that God put this car seat here for her and prayed with her. We were also able to gather more baby items such as a pack-n-play for her to take. This past year at the Christmas Extravaganza a familiar face holding a baby approached me and asked if I remembered her. As soon as she said it, I realized it was her. She hugged me and thanked us and told me how much it meant to get that baby stuff the year before.

Sometimes, in praying with and talking to people we discover other stories just like this. God works through this ministry to bless so many people. Thank you to everyone who volunteers or has volunteered for Christ's Closet. This ministry wouldn't be possible without you.
