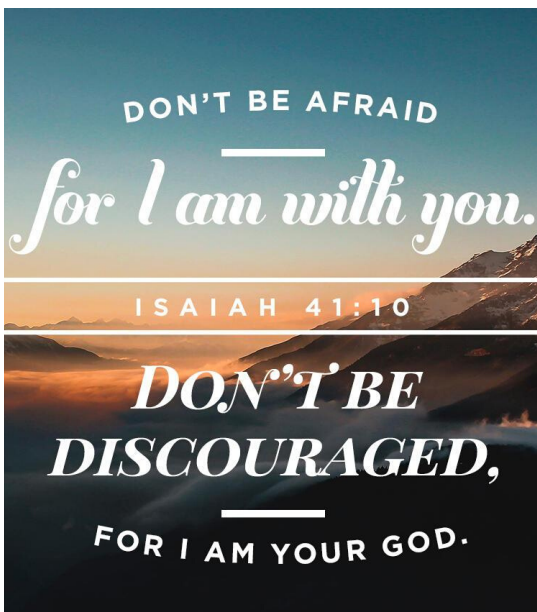
Youth Update
