
I question everything. I was invited to be on a debate team more than once. When I was invited to church many years ago, I questioned everything. I am certain several of the gray hairs on Clay's head are thanks to me and my questions.

We all have questions about the bible, our theology, our church, and our God. Is that difficult to admit? At times, it seems like there is a general idea that "good" Christians shouldn't ask the hard questions. Do we fear that others will find out that we don't know all of the answers? Does this limit us from speaking to others or even seeking counsel to find truth for ourselves?

God is bigger than my questions. I think the real question is: What do we do with our questions? Do we ignore them, or do we seek a deeper understanding of the truth? If we are honest in seeking the truth, Christianity, more specifically God, is waiting to lead us to Him...the source of truth. "Doubting" Thomas wasn't turned away but was shown Jesus was alive (John 20:24-29). The gospel of Luke begins (verses 1-4) with the statement that he investigated "everything from the beginning" to be certain of truth in what he had heard. If we seek God through questions, he deepens our faith and understanding of Him.

I am drawn to questions. Questions lead me to further study scripture and spend time in prayer. I am drawn to books and podcasts to help deepen my understanding of our savior. If you have a question you want to know more about, ask. You are not in this alone! Ask our pastor, ask a Shepherd, ask a wise friend. We are meant to be in community, learning and growing in our faith together.


