This pastor (Jerry Siasat) died from Covid this past week. He was only 59 and had trouble breathing and went to the hospital. The hospital was full and he could not be admitted. He was a faithful kingdom worker of the church and left behind his sweet wife Lolit, and three children.

We had another pastor (Imm Mapusao) in Bacolod pass away last month. Also, a pastor's wife in the mountains on the South part of Negros died from Covid. Few people have had the vaccines and there are very limited hospital beds!
